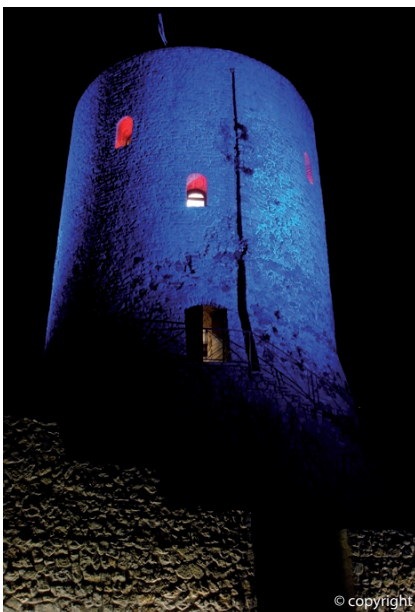


ANGEVIN TOWER

The suburb encircled from walls and the castle were probably built by Malerba family that kept the local feud in Norman epoch, the Norman-Swedish castle served as a feudal centre and as an important territorial garrison, especially referred to the valley runs and the no less important ways crossing the Partenio mountain. For the tower and its watchful presence which protects the country we realized a golden light which is symbol of historical preciousness but also a colour clearly visible in the night. This light is in harmony and dialogue with the starlight. The perimeter of the village and the surrounding streets are covered by a veil of blue moon light that simulates the presence of Diana on earth. From the street and from the village the blue colour is unobtrusive and does not disturb the vision of the tower. Light orientation is conceived to emphasize with slight shadow games the grandeur of the employed blocks.
