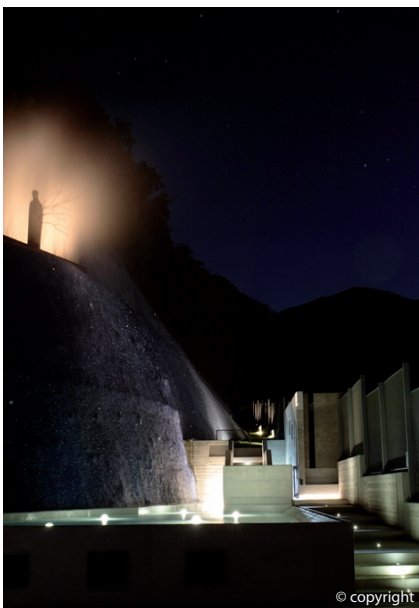


## ALTO CALORE AQUEDUCT

The entrance of a water tank becomes a work of art. The artist heals with a blue dye the functional cuts that the engineer made in the mountain and a heart covered with a cobalt blue grit opens in the rock. Lighting regulation just imitates human body heart movements: contraction (systole) – suffused light and relaxation (diastole) – intense light. There is also a connection with lunar phases: full moon-low lighting; absence of moon-brightest light. So rhythmic movements on earth align themselves with moon ones. LED light sources were employed in harmony with the environmental sustainability and energy saving of the project.
