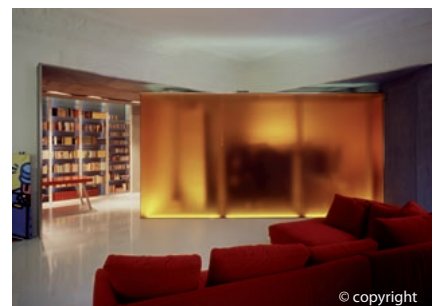
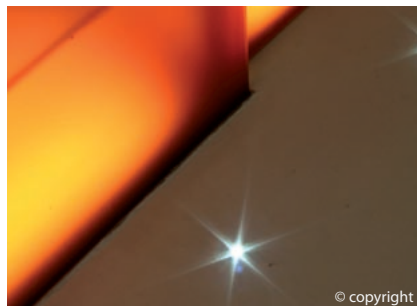

Light walls divide and create new spaces which are able to connect past and present. Large boxes of stained light create the link between the materiality of the stucco and the smoothness of cements, the light is the means by the different rooms of the house interact, is the medium that brings out the causing cuts of the walls and gives volume to the sculptural mass of the chimney. Light follows the folie architecturale of the designer, enhances its volumetric contrasts and highlights the dissonances; all that seems dystonic by its light and colours assumes harmony and tuning. The bright walls give a new value to the living space, volumes we inserted and material we used assume a tone and a heat which is different, unusual and charming; contrasts are searched and pointed out, the apartment becomes a sum of harmonic contrasts, contrast is the golden rule. The lamps seem to disappear in the ceiling behind the glass walls, their presence is discreet. It is a light that integrates with the architecture.
