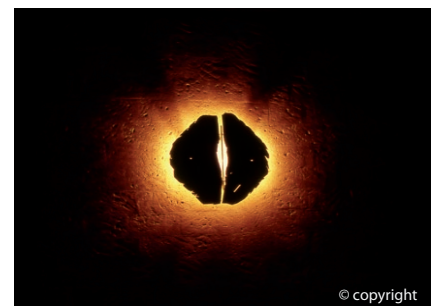


PRIVATE VILLA - LA MASSERIOLA

The lighting project of this private residence has been set, primarily, on the respect for the architectural history of the structure and the enhancement of the peculiarities of the place where it rises. The idea was a tale of light and shadow that connects the spaces fluidly making them welcoming and attracting: low and warm lights show a clean, essential style, and help to create an atmosphere of high impact where the shadow, thanks to the feelings that her mysterious charm can generate, becomes the undisputed protagonist. The effect produced on surfaces and materials plays a basic role not only in terms of aesthetic, but above all for the sensory aspect, each element is functional to the result for the relationship that it establishes with others: lights, colors, shapes, smells, materials are an integral part of the project, ingredients of an experiential mix that contribute to the creation of a welfare made to measure. We designed lamps ad hoc that interpret the history of light and land. Framers of the story and the fable, they appear as extras in a play, masks that symbolize the actors on the stage of the life of this enchanting place.
